MINUTES FROM May 21, 2014 MEETING

BELL CANYON COMMUNITY ROOM

Meeting called to order: 6:40 PM

1. The members approved the minutes from the March CAG meeting.
2. The members approved the agenda for the meeting.
3. Kathy Weiner introduced the meeting and the panel. Tom Seckington DTSC, Roger Paulson DTSC, Dave Dassler Boeing, Pete Zorba NASA and John Jones DOE made the groundwater presentations. Cassandra Owens WQCB made the surface water presentation.

The presentation material ranged from the SSFL groundwater sampling for contaminant and water flow and hydraulic management. Additional information was provided covering the sampling at the seeps and springs particularly those that migrate into surrounding communities. Remediation investigations were described that is taking place in various labs and with on-site testing.

One point made by all of the presenters was that no contaminants are moving off of the SSFL site. NASA and DOE mentioned that each is taking responsibility for the water studies and remediation efforts that will be made in their respective areas. The presentation that Owens made covered the water monitoring and permitting in the site outfalls.

The meeting then turned to the panel members answering written questions from the public. Although the questions ranged over all of the areas of the presentations, the major topics that were of interest to the public were the seeps and springs sampling and the findings.

4. The CAG resolution was approved by the members for future publication and distribution.

5. Approval of the papers prepared by Mike Kuhn regarding Simi drinking water and perchlorate locations were tabled until the next meeting.
6. The approval of the summary study made by Abe Weitzberg of the health effects of possible emissions from SSFL to surrounding communities was tabled until the next meeting to allow wider review and June meeting presentation of the study by Abe to the CAG members.
